- Shrimp 8,300 (EU 7,500 – GL 800)
- Greenland halibut 20,000 (GL 9,800)
- Mackerel 100,000 MT
- Herring 15,000
- Blue whiting 10,000
- Smelt 10,000
- Cod 10,000

- **QUOTAS 2014** in MT (main species)
- Shrimp 85,000 (GL 79,407 EU 3,400 Can 2,193)
- GL halibut 41,000 (C 26,000 + OS15,000)
- Cod 15,000
- Snow crab 2,550
- Salmon 35

Fisherman and the school system

- 5 or 6 yrs you start at school 1st grade
- Mandatory to 7th grade when most of active fishermen studied
- Today mandatory to 9th grade (few go for that)
- Major part takes 10th grade

- Some continue at vocational schools
- Some take high-school
- Others can attend residential school/folk high school or Piareersarfik (upgrade and counseling center)

Profile of fishermen and hunters

- * He will be around fifty
- * He will have a 7th grade school education
- * He will be monolingual
- * He will have either a dinghy, dogsled or a smaller boat as equipment

KNAPK's overall vision

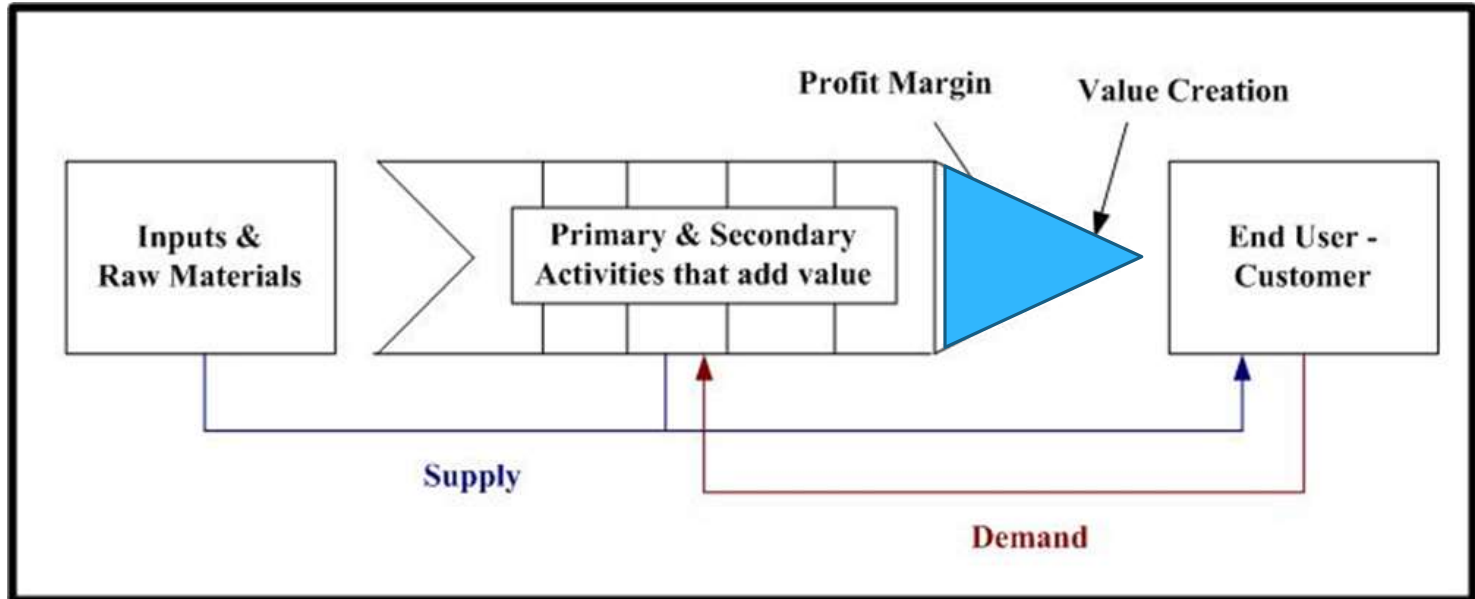
- * The maritime education must be upgraded on quality
- * The maritime school reputation shall be elevated
- * The "fishskipper of 1st grade" graduates must be able to communicate in second/third language (English)
- * Prerequisite to obtain a license; shall commit big off-shore companies to enroll minimum number of students. Graduates shall replace officers from abroad

Human skills

- * The traditional knowledge must be passed to him
- * He shall not be monolingual
- * He shall be graduated from the maritime school
- * He shall be ambitious
- * He shall be innovative
