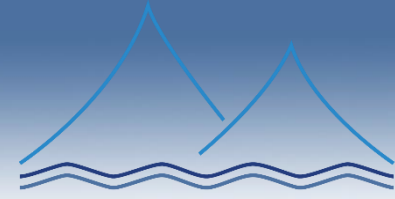

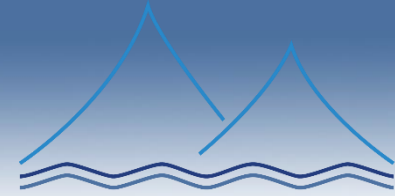

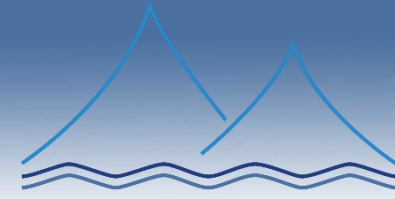

Aim of the conference

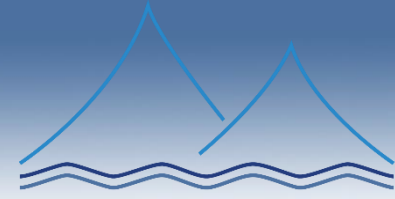
